A must-try is the 14km top-to-bottom route combining Blue 11, 10, and 1. For those who prefer reds, the Todorka and Banderitza chairlifts provide access to long, exhilarating runs like Red 2 and 4.

For Advanced Skiers Known for its extreme terrain and off-piste competitions, Bansko challenges advanced skiers with the Tomba black run and several demanding red runs.

For Snowboarders With long, wide runs and minimal drag lifts, Bansko is a great choice for snowboarders. Beginners can practice on quieter lower blue runs like 1A and 16. The resort also boasts the first snow park in the Balkans, featuring a mix of rails, jumps, and a halfpipe.
